Dear MLM Family,

Thank you for supporting us through another great year in 2024. As you know, we are ever growing our efforts to make a difference in the lives of those in need in the Greater Kansas City Area. I am proud that the following pages show how we lifted up over 34,000 people again this year. Not too bad for 25 staff members.

2024 saw us expand our affordable housing case management services to an additional four properties. We now help families living at: Eileen's Place, Brookwood at Antioch, Pendleton Flats, Pendleton ArtsBlock, Quinlan Place, and Quinlan Row for a total of 273 households.

We also expanded our services to include Street Outreach and have been actively involved in offering folks on the street, those living in tents, and those in make shift shelters resources so that they can continue to improve. This need has only increased as pressure to remove the homeless increases.

Of course, we continued operating all of our food programs, emergency assistance, a continuum of housing programs, and educational programs for self-sufficiency. As one of our new volunteers said, "I had no idea MLM was doing so much for so many! You all are like 10 nonprofits rolled into one!"


